- <u>Grade 11:</u> Will meet at the Rio Grande Visitor's Center in Pilar at 8:30 am to raft the Rio Grande "Racecourse" with Los Rios River Runners. Parents and/or students will be responsible for transportation and lunch.
- <u>Grade 12:</u> Attend Taos Academy for advisory meetings, to develop weekly schedules, get set up in classes, and engage in their assigned TA online coursework.

- <u>Grade 10:</u> Will be participating in Outdoor Education activities in Taos Ski Valley. Drop off is at 8 am at TSV at the base of Lift 4 and pick up is at 3 pm.
- <u>Grade 11:</u> Attend Taos Academy for advisory meetings, to develop weekly schedules, get set up in classes, and engage in their assigned TA online coursework.
- <u>Grade 12:</u> Will meet at the Rio Grande Visitor's Center in Pilar at 8:30 am to raft the Rio Grande "Racecourse" with Los Rios River Runners. Parents and/or students will be responsible for transportation and lunch.
- * College Link: Ms. Patricia Meagher and Ms. Kelci Pike will be working with you to develop your TA schedules during this Orientation Week based on your UNM classes as well as Enrichment and Capstone obligations. Please plan to attend full days for Orientation.

PLEASE NOTE that Monday 8/19 through Thursday 8/22, high school students will NOT be attending TA campus. They will be engaging with their online coursework and are required to stay on target with their pacing calendar for their digital coursework in Edgenuity. Students may attend the Student Success Lab at Taos Academy Monday through Thursday from 8-12, if needed.

MIDDLE SCHOOL STARTS THE WEEK OF:

Monday, August 19th – Thursday, 23rd School starts at 8am and ends at 4pm

Monday 8/19: School starts at 8am and concludes at 4pm for ALL middle school students, 5th-8th grades. Students will participate in a full day of orientation activities and begin coursework.

Tuesday 8/20: All middle school students on campus at 8 am. 5th and 6th graders will be dismissed at 12 noon for their outdoor leadership activities and overnight camping trip. 7th and 8th graders will remain on campus for the day to continue orientation until 4 pm.

Wednesday 8/21: 5th and 6th graders will continue on their outdoor leadership trip. Pickup and location TBA. 7th and 8th graders will be dismissed at 12 noon for their outdoor leadership activities and overnight camping trip.

Thursday 8/23: 7th and 8th graders will continue on their outdoor leadership trip. Pickup and location TBA. 5th and 6th graders will return to TA campus for the remainder of their orientation week from 8 am til 4 pm.

sites. In addition to the items on their gear list, students will need a sack lunch.
