


Dear Taos Academy Students and Families -

\sqcup	Graduation Requirements—Review your Semester 1 transcript and grades from Fall
	2021. Confirm with your advisory teacher and/or School Counselor that you will have
	all the credits you need to graduate in May.
	Complete your FAFSA-Go to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA,
	and fill out the application for the upcoming Fall 2022-23 college year. This is
	required for all 2022-2023 college students, and it is a free application. Please fill it out
	whether you have decided to attend college next Fall or not. Priority for financial aid is
	given on a first come basis. Please do not delay. If you need help filling out this
	application please reach out the school counselors at TA

	Prepare/Apply for Scholarships and College Admissions
	☐ Check the application deadlines for college admissions applications and
	scholarships, add them to your calendar and plan a timeline for completing the applications.

	☐ Ask teachers and other school staff for letters of recommendation. Make sure to ask 2-3 weeks before any deadlines.
	☐ Hunt for scholarship opportunities on the web. Check the TA school counseling
	page for local scholarship opportunities.
	☐ Draft essays needed for scholarship and college applications. Ask for help improving/editing these essays.
	☐ Complete applications a couple days before any deadlines so that you give

yourself plenty of time to fix any issues that could come up with your application.

Career Planning-If you do not plan on attending college and have another plan such as joining the Military, Peace Corps or taking a gap year, please check in with your school counselor as well, so that you will have everything you need for that next step.

Visit with the school counseling office— For any college/career planning help stop by our office or send us an email. We are here to help make your next steps after graduation as easy as possible.

Soak it up: Make sure you find time to enjoy your last semester of High School. Join a club or volunteer for something you've always wanted to try. Take time to savor the memories you have had and make new ones.
