Taos Academy Charter School is a state charter public school offering a dynamic and innovative educational delivery system. Taos Academy provides a free public educational choice to students of all ability levels and educational needs from grades five through twelve. It is our privilege to provide students with an engaging and rigorous core curriculum, highly motivating elective classes, leadership and career training, college preparation and community involvement through our state-of-the-art 21st century learning environment. The school opened in the Fall of 2009 and graduated its first senior class in the Spring of 2011.

Community Disruption from COVID-19: Due

to its nature as a blended learning school, Taos Academy's academic programming and high expectations for our students continued throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. We made no changes to our grading scales, policies, or requirements for graduation. For students who were unable to take state tests for graduation competencies, a local demonstration of mastery was put into place. While instruction moved to largely virtual (using a combination of synchronous and asynchronous engagement), we did not dramatically change our instructional methods, schedules, course offerings, or academic calendar. We could not be more proud of our students and their hard work during this challenging time!

GPA Calculation and Grading

TA grades will be calculated on a 4.0 scale; Honors coursework and Dual Credit classes will be weighted on a 5.0 scale. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. Passing mark is 60%. A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation.

Class Rank

Grades are recorded on the transcript and an exact, weighted GPA is computed at the end of each semester in January and May. Final class rank is determined at the end of Semester 1 senior year.

Honors classes offered

- English I, II, III, and IV
- Algebra I & II, Precalculus, Geometry, Probability & Statistics
- Environmental Science, Biology, Physics, Physical Science, Chemistry,
- US Economics, US Government, US History, and World History

*Students may opt to take an honors class but must pass the course with a 75% to receive the honors credit.

The College Link (CL) program serves as a support for participating dual credit students. It is open to eligible juniors and seniors with 3.0 GPA or higher. College Link students develop an individualized class schedule with their CL Advisor and may attend UNM-Taos campus classes during the week (Monday-Saturday). The flexible nature of our CL program was created to allow students more class choices throughout the week. Therefore, students are held accountable for demonstrated self-direction and motivation while successfully observing both UNM and Taos Academy academic requirements and school policies.
